

QUICK NOTES

If a South Carolina Beneficiary has Medicare Part B as their primary insurance carrier, enter carrier code 90798 when submitting the claim to SC Medicaid for secondary payment.

Please ensure the correct Medicaid ID Number is used when submitting claims.

LANCETS NOW ADDED TO THE SOUTH CAROLINA MEDICAID DIABETIC SUPPLIES PREFERRED LIST

Beginning with dates of service on or after July 1, 2016, the following lancets have been added to the South Carolina Medicaid Department of Health and Human Services Diabetic Supplies Preferred List. The following National Drug Codes (NDCs) may be billed through the Point-of-Sale (POS) system and do not require prior authorization.

All other NDCs will be denied through the POS system. These changes do not apply to Medicaid beneficiaries enrolled with a Managed Care Organization (MCO). Claims for services rendered to beneficiaries enrolled with a MCO should be filed to the MCO.
