Effective April 1, 2016, Medicaid providers must access a patient's controlled substance scripts via the SCRIPTS database before issuing a prescription. Bryan also discussed how pharmacy expenditures have outpaced historical trends and budget projections. He will engage the P&T committee to evaluate opportunities.
